

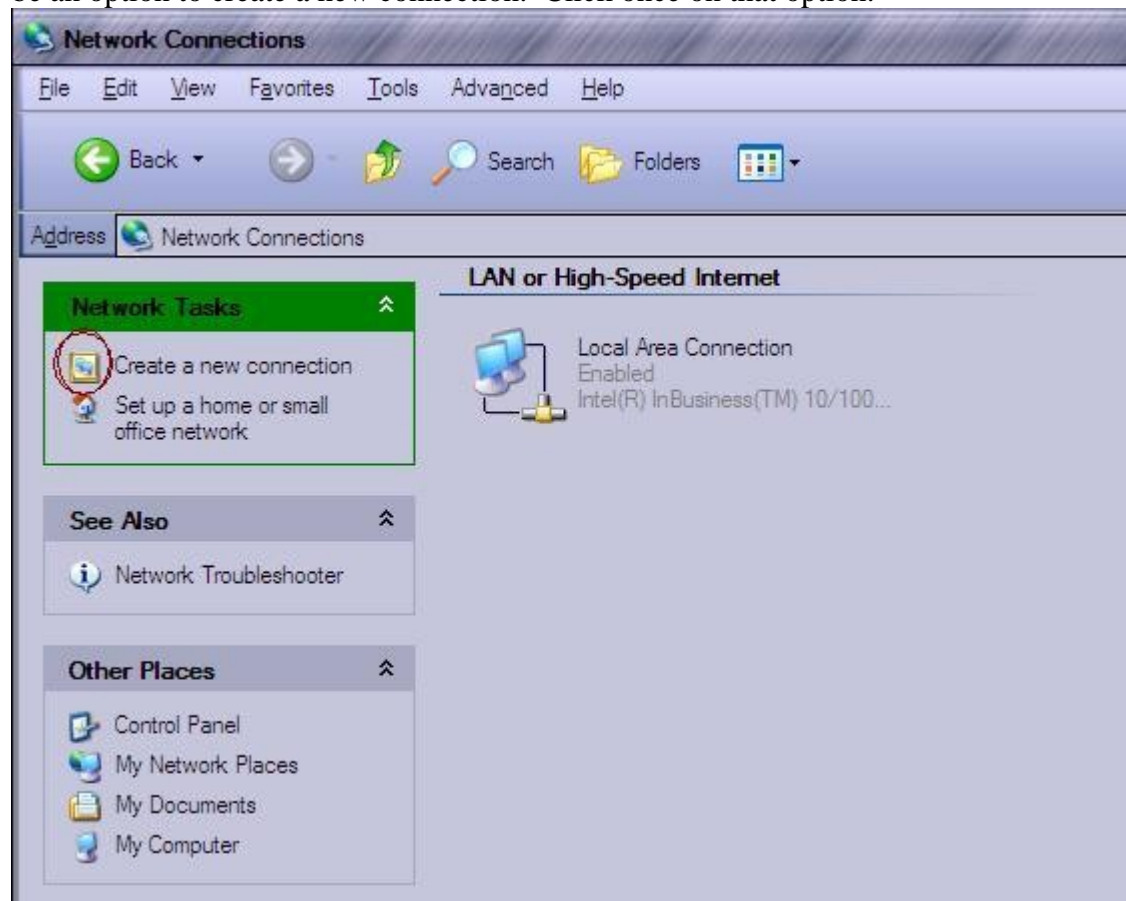

Setting up Dial-Up with Windows XP

Setting up your computer at home:

1. Click on the Start Menu and click once on the Control Panel Icon.
 - a. In Control Panel there are two possibilities
 - If you are in standard view double click on Network Connections.
 - If you're in the category view click once on Internet and Network Connections. And then click once on Network Connections.
2. Once you are in network connections, over on the left hand side there will be an option to create a new connection. Click once on that option.



3. You will see a new connection wizard. Click on next once and click on the option connect to the internet.
4. Click 'Next'
5. Then click on the option to Setup My Connection Manually.
6. Click 'Next'
7. Click on connect using a Dial-up modem.
8. Click 'Next'

9. In the connection name type in 'GRCC'
10. Click 'Next'.
11. The dial-up number is 234-3717.
12. You will be asked for your user name and password.

User Name: The College Network ID that you use to log onto the computer.

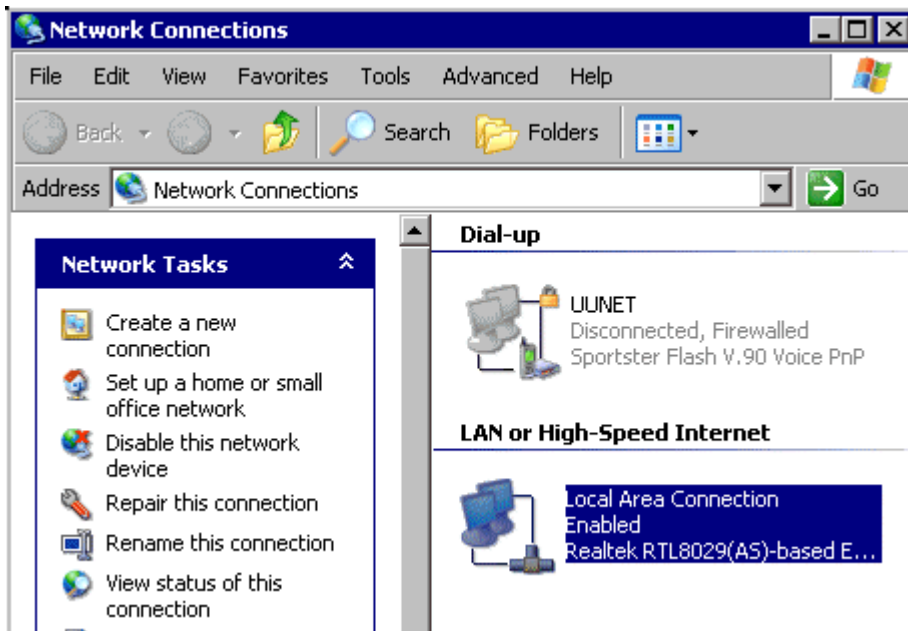
Password: The College Network password that you use to log onto the computer.

13. After you have finished typing in your College Network ID and password and then confirm your password, click on 'Next' and then click 'Finish'.


To connect to the College, double-click your 'GRCC' connection that you have created.

Please remember: The internet is accessible through this connection, but GRCC is not an internet service provider.

Problems with DHCP for Dialup Connections

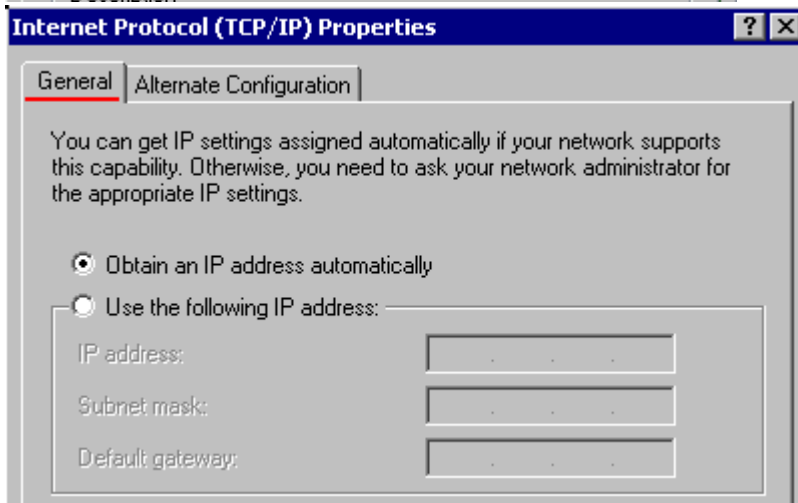
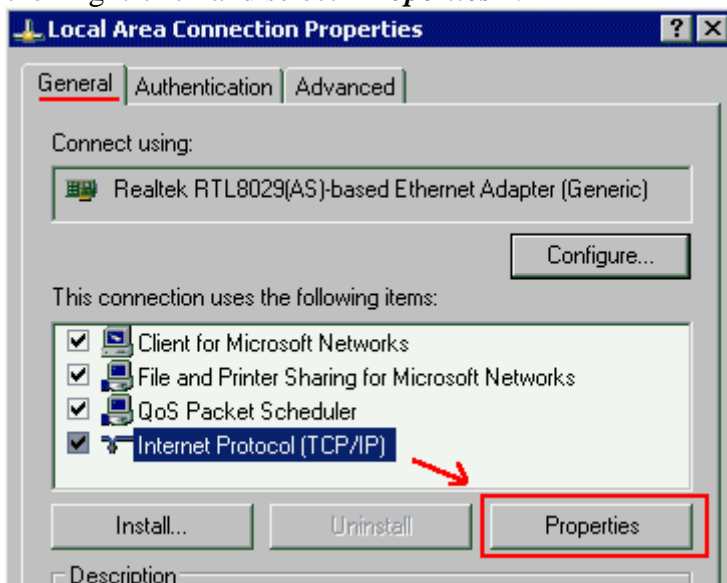


In the Control-Panel, select the Network Connection icon:

Select your Local Area

Connection, then right-click and select "*Properties*".
